Establishing a Joint Committee on the Alaska Legislative Ethics Act of 1990.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Alaska Legislative Ethics Act of 1990 prepared by the Joseph and Edna Josephson Institute for the Advancement of Ethics was recently presented to the legislature; and

WHEREAS the proposed Act is very lengthy and many questions have arisen regarding the proposal, and the sooner both houses can begin joint hearings on the Act the more information each house can have;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that a Joint Committee on the Alaska Legislative Ethics Act of 1990 is established, consisting of three members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate and three members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee consider CSSB 415(Jud) and HB 596, which will incorporate the Alaska Legislative Ethics Act of 1990, and report to the legislature by May 2, 1990, recommended legislation based on the proposed Act; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the joint committee is terminated May 2, 1990.
