2 to the internal management of state agencies and their adoption is not subject to the Administrative  
3 Procedure Act (AS 44.62). The regulations shall be published in the Alaska Administrative  
4 Register and Code for informational purposes.

5 \* **Sec. 11. EMPLOYEES OF THE JUDICIAL AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES, AND CERTAIN**  
6 **EXEMPT EMPLOYEES OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH.** The following employees are entitled to  
7 receive salary adjustments comparable to those received by the classified and partially exempt employees  
8 of the executive branch under AS 39.27.011(a) as that subsection is reenacted in sec. 9 of this Act:

9 (1) judges and permanent and temporary employees of the judicial branch;

10 (2) legislators and permanent and temporary employees of the legislative branch, including  
11 staff of the ombudsman's office;

12 (3) permanent and temporary employees of the executive branch who are in the exempt  
13 service under AS 39.25, who are not members of a collective bargaining unit established under the  
14 Public Employment Relations Act (AS 23.40), and who are not otherwise covered by AS 39.27.011(a).

15 \* **Sec. 12. EMPLOYEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA.** The employees of the University  
16 of Alaska who are not members of a collective bargaining unit are entitled to receive salary increases  
17 in accordance with the compensation policy of the board of regents of the University of Alaska.

18 \* **Sec. 13.** This Act is retroactive to January 1, 1991.

19 \* **Sec. 14.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
