7 * Section 1. AS 14.43.120 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

8 (s) A portion of a loan shall be forgiven by the state if, after being enrolled in the course
9 of study for which the loan was granted, the borrower is a student who is unable to complete the
10 school term as a result of serving on active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United
11 States. The portion of the loan that shall be forgiven by the state is equal to the amount
12 borrowed by the student for the school term in which the borrower's studies are terminated.

13 (t) Forgiveness under (s) of this section is subject to appropriation by the legislature.
14 Money obtained from the sale of bonds by the Student Loan Corporation under AS 14.42.220
15 may not be appropriated for the forgiveness of loans.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 14.43.740(a) is amended to read:

17 (a) The provisions of AS 14.43.100, 14.43.110, 14.43.115, 14.43.120(a) - (d), (i), (m),
18 and ~~(r) - (t)~~ [(r)], and 14.43.135 apply to a loan made under AS 14.43.710 - 14.43.790.

19 * Sec. 3. This Act applies to principal and interest due on a loan entered into on or after July 1, 1990.

20 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
