1 Relating to the licensing requirements for architects, engineers, and land surveyors.
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5 * Section 1. AS 08.48.331 is amended to read:

6 Sec. 08.48.331. EXEMPTIONS. This chapter does not apply to

7 (1) a contractor performing work designed by a professional architect or engineer
8 or the supervision of the construction of the work as a supervisor or superintendent for a
9 contractor;

10 (2) workers in building trades crafts, superintendents, supervisors, or inspectors
11 in the performance of their customary duties;

12 (3) an officer or employee of the United States government practicing architecture,
13 engineering, or land surveying as required by the person's official capacity;

14 (4) an employee or a subordinate of a person registered under this chapter if the
15 work or service is done under the direct supervision of a person registered under this chapter;

16 (5) associates, consultants, or specialists retained by a registered individual, a
17 partnership of registered individuals, or a corporation authorized to practice architecture,
18 engineering, or land surveying under this chapter, in the performance of professional services if
19 responsible charge of the work remains with the individual, the partnership, or a designated
20 representative of the corporation;

21 (6) a person preparing drawings or specifications for

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1 (A) a building for the person's own use and occupancy as a single family
2 residence;

3 (B) farm or ranch buildings, unless the public health, safety, or welfare
4 is involved;

5 (C) a building that is intended to be used only as a residence by not more
6 than four families and that is not more than two stories high;

7 (D) a garage, workshop, or similar building that contains less than 2,000
8 square feet of floor space to be used for a private noncommercial purpose;

9 (7) a specialty contractor licensed under AS 08.18 while engaged in the business
10 of construction contracting or designing systems for work within the specialty to be performed
11 or supervised by the specialty contractor, or a contractor preparing shop or field drawings for
12 work that the specialty contractor has contracted to perform;

13 (8) a person furnishing drawings, specifications, instruments of service, or other
14 data for alterations or repairs to a building that do not change or affect the structural system or
15 the safety of the building, or that do not affect the public health, safety, or welfare;

16 (9) a person who is employed by a postsecondary educational institution to
17 teach engineering, architectural, or land surveying courses; in this paragraph,
18 "postsecondary educational institution" has the meaning given in AS 14.48.210.
