7 [MARCH 15] of each year, the administrative director of courts shall prepare for each
8 judicial district a list of the names of the residents of the district who are qualified by
9 law for jury service. If the superior court is located in different cities in the same
10 judicial district, the administrative director shall prepare for each location of the court
11 a list of the names of the qualified residents of that portion of the district considered
12 to be appropriate.

Chapter 7

1 Revenue of all persons who filed an application for a distribution of Alaska permanent
2 fund income under AS 43.23 during the current [PRECEDING] calendar year that
3 shows an Alaskan address, and of all persons who volunteer for jury duty under (d)
4 of this section. If considered necessary by the administrative director of the Alaska
5 Court System, the jury list shall incorporate a list prepared by the Department of
6 Public Safety of all persons who hold a valid Alaska driver's license. The departments
7 shall submit their respective lists to the Alaska Court System not later than
8 September 30 [JANUARY 15] of each year. To the extent that it is available, the
9 departments shall include on the lists they submit the following information for each
10 person: first name, middle initial, and last name; mailing address, including the zip
11 code; and birth date. The lists shall be recorded on magnetic tape compatible with
12 Alaska Court System data processing equipment.
