As required by AS.60.080(d) and in compliance with AS.24.60.080(c), this is to advise you that I traveled to the following two sites at the expense of the host, on the dates and for the purposes shown.

On November 25 & 26 I traveled to the Endicott Operations on the North Slope, to observe the first offshore oil and gas operations in the Arctic Ocean. B. P. Alaska paid full expenses for the trip which are estimated at \$550.

On December 9, 1992, I traveled to the Alyeska Tanker Terminal and Oil Spill Response Facilities at Valdez to observe the operation of the Terminal facilities, the Alyeska initial oil spill equipment, and to visit the U.S. Coast Guard Observation and Response office in Valdez. Alyeska Pipeline Company paid full expenses for the trip which are estimated at \$250.

Both of these facility visits will be helpful in reviewing existing and any future legislation pertaining to oil and gas matters.
