A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act prohibiting certain retail sales of cigarettes."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** PURPOSE. It is the purpose of this Act to prohibit retail sales of single
4 cigarettes, except when packaged singly by the manufacturer.

5 * **Sec. 2.** AS 11.76 is amended by adding a new section to read:

6 Sec. 11.76.108. PROHIBITED RETAIL SALES OF CIGARETTES. (a) A
7 person who holds a business license endorsement under AS 43.70.075, or an agent or
8 employee of the person, may not sell cigarettes to another person unless the cigarettes
9 are sold in the manufacturer's original packaging material. In this subsection,
10 "packaging material" means a cigarette pack, carton, or box.

11 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a violation.
