7 (B) parent or legal guardian if the individual was under the
8 age of 21 years and a full-time student during eight of the last 12 months
9 and intends to resume full-time student status within the next four months;

11 (C) mother or father if the service is performed by a child
12 under the age of 18 [IN THE EMPLOY OF THE CHILD'S FATHER OR

14 * Sec. 2. This Act applies to service performed on or after the effective date of this Act.
