**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act changing the date that the legislature convenes in the years following  
2 a gubernatorial election."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** AS 24.05.090 is amended to read:

5           Sec. 24.05.090. REGULAR SESSIONS. The legislature shall convene at the  
6 capital each year on the second Monday in January at 10:00 a.m.; however, following  
7 a gubernatorial election year, the legislature shall convene on the third **Tuesday**  
8 **[MONDAY]** in January at 10:00 a.m. Except as provided in this section, each  
9 legislature shall have a duration of two years and shall consist of a "First Regular  
10 Session," which shall meet in the odd-numbered years, and a "Second Regular  
11 Session," which shall meet in the even-numbered years, and any special session or  
12 sessions **that** **[WHICH]** the governor or legislature may find necessary to call.
