**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act establishing an exemption to the requirement of obtaining a waste**  
2 **disposal permit for certain activities that yield water and waste material discharges**  
3 **ancillary to those activities."**

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 \* **Section 1.** AS 46.03.100 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 (f) Except as to discharges arising out of exploration and development drilling  
7 for oil and gas resources, this section does not apply to waste material discharges or  
8 water discharges that will arise from the following activities if the discharge is  
9 incidental to the activity, the activity is carried out in a manner consistent with  
10 established industry procedures, and the activity does not produce a direct discharge  
11 from a point source, as that term is defined in regulations adopted under this chapter,  
12 into any surface water of the state:

13 (1) mineral drilling, trenching, and similar activities;

14 (2) facility construction and maintenance;

- 1 (3) road or other transportation facility construction and maintenance;
- 2 (4) landscaping;
- 3 (5) well drilling, geophysical drilling, or coal bed methane drilling; and
- 4 (6) bilge pumping, unless the bilge product pumped includes oily
- 5 sludge, oily refuse, or any mixture of oil with the pumped wastes.
