A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to access to extracurricular school programs by home schooled
2 students."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 14.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 Sec. 14.30.025. HOME SCHOOLED STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN
6 PUBLIC SCHOOL PROGRAMS. (a) A governing body may not deny a student who
7 is not in attendance within the school district the right to participate in extracurricular
8 activities occurring in the school district if the student

9 (1) is receiving academic education at the student's residence as
10 permitted under AS 14.30.010(b); and

11 (2) otherwise meets all school district eligibility requirements for
12 participation in the activity that are applicable to a student who is in attendance in the
13 school district.

14 (b) In this section,

- 1 (1) "extracurricular activities" include drama, debate, music, band, and
2 athletic activities;
3 (2) "school district" means a municipal school district or a regional
4 educational attendance area.
