**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act providing that the commissioner of education serves at the pleasure of**  
2 **the Board of Education; and providing for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 14.07.145(c) is amended to read:

5 (c) The commissioner serves at the pleasure of the board and may **not** be  
6 appointed by the board for a term of office [NOT TO EXCEED FIVE YEARS. THE  
7 COMMISSIONER MAY BE REMOVED DURING A TERM OF OFFICE BY FOUR  
8 MEMBERS OF THE BOARD FOR CAUSE AS DEFINED IN THIS SECTION].

9 **\* Sec. 2.** AS 14.07.145(f) is repealed.

10 **\* Sec. 3.** This Act applies to appointments made by the Board of Education on or after the  
11 effective date of this Act.

12 **\* Sec. 4.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
