**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to the membership of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** AS 04.06.020 is amended to read:

4           Sec. 04.06.020. APPOINTMENT AND QUALIFICATIONS. The board  
5 consists of five members appointed by the governor and confirmed by a majority of  
6 the members of the legislature in joint session. A member of the board may not hold  
7 any other state or federal office, either elective or appointive. Two members of the  
8 board shall be persons actively engaged in the alcoholic beverage industry, except that  
9 no member may hold a wholesale license or be an officer, agent, or employee of a  
10 wholesale alcoholic beverage enterprise. **One member shall be a person actively**  
11 **engaged in a public health occupation. One member shall be a person actively**  
12 **engaged in a public safety or law enforcement occupation.** No three members of  
13 the board may be engaged in the same business, occupation, or profession.

14 \* **Sec. 2.** APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to persons appointed on or after the effective  
15 date of this Act. The governor shall implement this Act as vacancies occur on the Alcoholic

**1 Beverage Control Board.**
