A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to civil liability of volunteer school crossing guards; and
2 providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 09.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 Sec. 09.65.094. CIVIL LIABILITY OF VOLUNTEER CROSSING GUARD.

6 A person who provides volunteer crossing guard services to assist students to reach or
7 depart from a public school may not be held civilly liable for damages resulting from
8 an act or omission in performing the crossing guard services, unless the act or
9 omission constitutes gross negligence, recklessness, or intentional misconduct. In this
10 section, "volunteer" means a person who does not receive monetary compensation for
11 performing services.

12 * **Sec. 2.** This Act applies to a claim for relief that accrues on or after the effective date
13 of this Act.

14 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect July 1, 1995.
