A BILL**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act making appropriations to the Department of Education for support of
 2 kindergarten, primary, and secondary education and for community schools
 3 programs for fiscal year 1996 and fiscal year 1997; making appropriations from
 4 the constitutional budget reserve fund under art. IX, sec. 17(c), Constitution of
 5 the State of Alaska; and providing for an effective date."

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

7 * **Section 1.** (a) The sum of \$696,527,188 is appropriated from the budget reserve fund
 8 (art. IX, sec. 17, Constitution of the State of Alaska) to the Department of Education for the
 9 purposes expressed and allocated in the amounts listed for operating expenditures for the fiscal
 10 year ending June 30, 1996:

26 * **Sec. 3.** The appropriations from the budget reserve fund (art. IX, sec. 17, Constitution
27 of the State of Alaska) contained in this Act are made under art. IX, sec. 17(c), Constitution
28 of the State of Alaska.

29 * **Sec. 4.** Except for sec. 2 of this Act, this Act takes effect July 1, 1995.

30 * **Sec. 5.** Section 2 of this Act takes effect July 1, 1996.
