FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to false statements and omissions in regard to application for
2 fish and game licenses, tags, and permits and to nonresident hunters."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 16.05.420(b) is repealed and reenacted to read:

5 (b) A person may not make a false statement, or omit a material fact, in an
6 application for a license, tag, or permit issued under AS 16.05.330 - 16.05.430. A
7 person who without any culpable mental state violates this subsection is guilty of a
8 violation and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500. A person
9 who knowingly violates this subsection is guilty of unsworn falsification under
10 AS 11.56.210.

11 * **Sec. 2.** AS 16.05.430(a) is amended to read:

12 (a) Except as provided in AS 16.05.407(b) and (d), 16.05.408(b), and
13 16.05.420(b) [AS 16.05.420(b)], a person who violates AS 16.05.330 - 16.05.420 or
14 a regulation adopted under AS 16.05.330 - 16.05.420 is guilty of a misdemeanor and

1 upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment
2 for not more than six months, or by both.
