A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the crime of violating a domestic violence restraining order."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * **Section 1.** AS 11.56.740(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) A person commits the crime of violating a domestic violence restraining
5 order if [(1)] the person knowingly violates a provision of an order issued under
6 AS 25.35.010(b) or 25.35.020

7 (1) restraining the person from communicating directly or indirectly
8 with another;

9 (2) restraining the person from subjecting another to domestic
10 violence;

11 (3) directing the person to vacate the home of another; or

12 (4) restraining the person from entering a propelled vehicle in the
13 possession of or occupied by another [AND (2) AT THE TIME THE
14 RESTRAINING ORDER WAS ISSUED, THE COURT MADE A FINDING THAT
15 THE PERSON HAD SUBJECTED ANOTHER TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE].
