A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act providing for restitution to the state for the unlawful taking of game."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 16.05.925 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

4 (b) In addition to a penalty imposed under (a) of this section, a person who
5 unlawfully takes an animal listed in this subsection shall pay restitution to the state in
6 the amount set out in this subsection for each animal unlawfully taken:

- 7 (1) Bear, black \$ 600
- 8 (2) Bear, brown or grizzly 1,300
- 9 (3) Bison 1,300
- 10 (4) Caribou 850
- 11 (5) Deer 400
- 12 (6) Elk 800
- 13 (7) Goat 800
- 14 (8) Moose 1,000
- 15 (9) Musk oxen 3,000

1	(10) Sheep	1,100
2	(11) Wolf	500
3	(12) Wolverine	500.
