**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to fees charged by the Department of Environmental**  
2 **Conservation."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 44.46.025(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) The Department of Environmental Conservation may adopt regulations that  
6 prescribe reasonable fees, and establish procedures for the collection of the fees, to  
7 cover the applicable direct costs, not including travel, of inspections, permit  
8 preparation and administration, **and** plan review and approval [, AND OTHER  
9 SERVICES] provided by the department relating to

10 (1) agriculture and animals under AS 03.05; food, drugs, and cosmetics  
11 under AS 17.20; and public accommodations and facilities under AS 18.35;

12 (2) certificates of inspection for motor vehicles under AS 46.14.400 or  
13 46.14.510;

14 (3) sewerage system and treatment works and wastewater disposal

1 systems, and drinking water systems, under AS 46.03.720;  
2 (4) [REPEALED  
3 (5) REPEALED  
4 (6)] water and wastewater operator training under AS 46.30;  
5 (5) [(7) CONTROL OF SOLID WASTE FACILITIES UNDER  
6 AS 46.03.020(10) AND 46.03.100;  
7 (8)] certification of laboratories conducting environmental analyses of  
8 public drinking water systems or of oil or hazardous substances, or conducting other  
9 analyses required by the department;  
10 (6) [(9)] certification of federal permits or authorizations under 33  
11 U.S.C. 1341, sec. 401 (Clean Water Act).

12 \* **Sec. 2.** APPLICABILITY. This Act does not apply to services performed by the  
13 Department of Environmental Conservation before the effective date of this Act.
