**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act amending the definition of the offense of unlawful interference with  
2 voting in the first degree, a class C felony, to include conduct related to inducing  
3 a person to vote or to refrain from voting at an election and conduct related  
4 to acceptance of something offered or given to vote or to refrain from voting in  
5 an election."

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

7 \* **Section 1.** AS 15.56.030(a) is amended to read:

8 (a) A person commits the crime of unlawful interference with voting in the  
9 first degree if the person

10 (1) uses, threatens to use, or causes to be used force, coercion, violence,  
11 or restraint; or if the person inflicts, threatens to inflict, or causes to be inflicted  
12 damage, harm, or loss upon or against another person to induce or compel that person  
13 to vote or refrain from voting for a candidate in an election or for any election

1 proposition or question;

2 (2) gives, promises to give, offers, or causes to be given or offered  
3 money or other valuable thing to a person with the intent to induce the person **to vote**  
4 **or to refrain from voting at an election, or to induce the person** to vote for or  
5 refrain from voting for a candidate at an election or for an election proposition or  
6 question; or

7 (3) solicits, accepts, or agrees to accept money or other valuable thing  
8 with the intent **to vote or to refrain from voting at an election, or with the intent**  
9 to vote for or refrain from voting for a candidate at an election or for an election  
10 proposition or question.
