**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act establishing a vehicle operation curfew for minors."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 **\* Section 1.** AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4           Sec. 28.35.265. VEHICLE OPERATION CURFEW. (a) A person under 17  
5 years of age for whom the disabilities of minority have not been removed for general  
6 purposes under AS 09.55.590 and who has not arrived at the age of majority under  
7 AS 25.20.020 may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of midnight and 5:00  
8 a.m. unless the person is

9                           (1) accompanied by the person's parent or guardian;

10                           (2) engaged in an employment activity, or going to or returning from  
11 an employment activity, without detour or stop; or

12                           (3) attending, going to, or returning from a school activity, without  
13 detour or stop.

14                   (b) Vehicle operation curfew is a traffic statute for purposes of  
15 AS 47.10.010(b).

(c) Violation of vehicle operation curfew under this section is an infraction.
