A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to motor vehicle registration and motor vehicle registration fees;
2 and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 28.10.021 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (d) The department shall establish procedures that allow a person who renews
6 registration for a commercial or noncommercial vehicle to renew registration by mail.

7 * **Sec. 2.** AS 28.10.108(b) is amended to read:

8 (b) Subject to the provisions of (f) of this section, a vehicle subject to
9 registration

10 (1) under AS 28.10.011 and 28.10.421(b)(3) and (4) and (c)(1) - (4)
11 shall have its initial registration, and may have its annual registration, renewed during
12 the month of December;

13 (2) under AS 28.10.181, 28.10.411 and 28.10.421(d)(3) and (8) [(9)]
14 shall have its initial registration, and may have its annual registration, renewed during

1 the month of January.

2 * **Sec. 3.** AS 28.10.421(a) is amended to read:

3 (a) Unless otherwise provided by law,

4 (1) the fees prescribed in this section shall be paid to the department
5 at the times provided under AS 28.10.108 and 28.10.111; and

6 (2) [AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$10 SHALL BE ADDED TO] the
7 registration fee set out in this section **shall be reduced by \$5 when** [FOR] registration
8 **is** [NOT] conducted by mail **and may be reduced by \$5 when registration is**
9 **conducted by electronic transmission** [; THE DEPARTMENT MAY WAIVE THIS
10 ADDITIONAL FEE FOR A GOOD CAUSE BASED ON CRITERIA ESTABLISHED
11 IN REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT].

14 following classifications for:

15 (1) a passenger vehicle or motor home not used or maintained for the
16 transportation of persons or property for hire or for other commercial use
17 **\$40** [\$35];

18 (2) a pick-up truck or a van not exceeding 6,000 pounds unladen
19 weight and not used or maintained for the transportation of persons or property for hire
20 or for other commercial use **\$45** [\$40];

21 (3) a taxicab **\$75** [\$70];

22 (4) a motor bus with a seating capacity for 20 or more persons and
23 used exclusively for commercial purposes in the transporting of visitors or tourists
24 **\$90** [\$85];

25 (5) a motorcycle or a motor-driven cycle **\$25** [\$20];

26 (6) a trailer not used or maintained for the transportation of persons
27 or property for hire or for other commercial use, including, but not limited to, a boat
28 trailer, baggage trailer, box trailer, utility trailer, house trailer, travel trailer, or a trailer
29 rented or offered for rent **\$10** [\$ 5].

31 (c) The annual registration fees under this subsection are imposed and are

1 based upon the actual unladen weight as established by the manufacturer's advertised
2 weight or upon the actual weight which the owner shall furnish, subject to the approval
3 of the commissioner or the commissioner's representative, for a vehicle, including a
4 motor vehicle pulling a trailer or semi-trailer, that is registered in the name of a
5 company or business, or is used or maintained for the transportation of passengers for
6 hire, excepting taxicabs and buses under (b) of this section, or for the transportation
7 of property for hire or for other commercial purposes, including a trailer, semi-trailer,
8 truck, wrecker, tow car, hearse, ambulance, and tractor, as follows:

- 9 (1) up to and including 5,000 pounds **\$56** [\$51];
- 10 (2) more than 5,000 pounds to and including 12,000 pounds
11 **\$91** [\$86];
- 12 (3) more than 12,000 pounds to and including 18,000 pounds
13 **\$161** [\$156];
- 14 (4) more than 18,000 pounds **\$226** [\$221].

16 (d) The special registration fees under this subsection are imposed annually,
17 unless otherwise specified, for:

- 18 (1) an historic vehicle (one time only upon initial registration under
19 AS 28.10.181) \$10;
- 20 (2) special request plates for
 - 21 (A) Alaska National Guard personnel \$30;
 - 22 (B) veterans or retired veterans \$30;
 - 23 (C) recipients of the Purple Heart \$30;
 - 24 (D) owners of custom collector vehicles \$50;
 - 25 (E) other special request plates \$30;

26 plus the fee required for that vehicle under (b) of this section; the fee required
27 by this paragraph shall be collected only on the first issuance and on the
28 replacement of special request plates;

10 (A) with a transceiver capable of less than 5-band operation

12 (B) in recognition of service to the public: a mobile amateur

13 radio station owned by an amateur with general class or higher license,

14 provided the station must be satisfactorily proved capable of operating on at

15 least five bands from 160 through 10 meters, must have an antenna, and must

16 have a power supply and wiring as a permanent part of the vehicle; the

1 paragraph shall be collected only on the first issuance and on the replacement of

3 university campus designation for the fees received under this paragraph that the
4 department deposits in the general fund; the annual estimated balance in the accounts
5 that is in excess of the cost of issuing special request university plates may be
6 appropriated by the legislature for the support of programs at each campus.
