**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to the Board of Storage Tank Assistance; and providing for an  
2 effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** AS 44.66.010(a)(18) is amended to read:

5 (18) Board of Storage Tank Assistance (AS 46.03.360) - June 30, 2000  
6 [1996];

7 \* **Sec. 2.** AS 46.03.360(a) is amended to read:

8 (a) There is established the Board of Storage Tank Assistance. For  
9 administrative purposes, the board is located in the department. The board consists of  
10 the commissioners of environmental conservation and transportation and public  
11 facilities, or their designees, and the following persons who shall be appointed by the  
12 governor to serve at the pleasure of the governor for staggered four-year terms:

13 (1) an engineer registered under AS 08.48 who is knowledgeable about  
14 installing, upgrading, repairing, or closing underground petroleum storage tank

1 systems;

2 (2) a general contractor registered under AS 08.18 who is  
3 knowledgeable about installing, upgrading, repairing, or closing underground petroleum  
4 storage tank systems;

5 (3) two persons who own or operate an underground petroleum storage  
6 tank system, at least one of whom does not own or operate more than 10 underground  
7 petroleum storage tanks; [AND]

8 (4) a member of the insurance industry; **and**

9 **(5) a person who is a member of the general public who does not**  
10 **have a financial interest in replacing, upgrading, closing, testing, or cleaning up**  
11 **releases from the type of underground storage tank that is governed by**  
12 **AS 46.03.360 - 46.03.450.**

13 \* **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect July 1, 1996.
