**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Relating to correcting errors in a workers' compensation pamphlet published by**  
2 **the Department of Labor.**

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **WHEREAS** the division of workers' compensation within the Alaska Department  
5 of Labor performs essential duties relating to claims from injured workers across the  
6 state; and

7 **WHEREAS** workers' compensation claims benefit thousands of employees across  
8 the state; and

9 **WHEREAS** claims for insured compensation and insurance premiums result in  
10 expenditure of millions of dollars in the state each year; and

11 **WHEREAS** it is crucial that employees and employers have current and accurate  
12 information from the division of workers' compensation in order to file and defend  
13 claims; and

14 **WHEREAS** the division of workers' compensation has prepared a pamphlet to  
15 assist both employees and employers in understanding and using the workers'  
16 compensation system; and

1           **WHEREAS** both employees and employers rely on information published by the  
2 division of workers' compensation in the workers' compensation pamphlet; and

3           **WHEREAS** the most recent edition of this workers' compensation pamphlet  
4 contains errors and inconsistencies, particularly regarding requirements of the American  
5 with Disabilities Act;

6           **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests the  
7 Governor to direct the commissioner of labor to correct the errors and inconsistencies  
8 in the workers' compensation pamphlet through an erratum insert and upon the next  
9 publication.
