A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act repealing an additional fee for motor vehicle registration not conducted
2 by mail and limiting motor vehicle emissions inspection to once every two years."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 28.10.421(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) Unless otherwise provided by law,

6 [(1)] the fees prescribed in this section shall be paid to the department
7 at the times provided under AS 28.10.108 and 28.10.111 [; AND

8 (2) AN ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$10 SHALL BE ADDED TO THE
9 REGISTRATION FEE SET OUT IN THIS SECTION FOR REGISTRATION NOT
10 CONDUCTED BY MAIL; THE DEPARTMENT MAY WAIVE THIS ADDITIONAL
11 FEE FOR A GOOD CAUSE BASED ON CRITERIA ESTABLISHED IN
12 REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT].

13 * **Sec. 2.** AS 46.14.400 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

14 (i) If a municipality or a local air quality district administering a program

1 under this section requires emissions inspection for a motor vehicle, emission
2 inspection may not be required more than once every two years.

3 * **Sec. 3.** AS 46.14.510 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (e) If the department adopts regulations requiring emissions inspection for a
5 motor vehicle, the department may not require the vehicle be inspected more than once
6 every two years.
