A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the use of off-road vehicles in the vicinity of the Dalton
2 Highway."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 19.40.210 is amended to read:

5 Sec. 19.40.210. PROHIBITION OF OFF-ROAD VEHICLES. Off-road
6 vehicles are prohibited on land within five miles of the right-of-way of the highway.

7 However, this prohibition does not apply to

8 (1) off-road vehicles

9 (A) being used in support of lawful trapping; or

10 (B) necessary for oil and gas exploration, development,
11 production, or transportation; or

12 (2) [TO] a person who holds a mining claim in the vicinity of the
13 highway **or operates a trapline in the vicinity of the highway** and who must use
14 land within five miles of the right-of-way of the highway to gain access to the mining

1 claim or the trapline.
