A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to general grant land entitlements for the Denali Borough."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 29.65.010(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) The general grant land entitlement of each of the municipalities in this
5 subsection is the amount set out opposite each:

6 (1) Municipality of Anchorage - 44,893 acres;

7 (2) City and Borough of Juneau - 19,584 acres;

8 (3) City and Borough of Sitka - 10,500 acres;

9 (4) Bristol Bay Borough - 2,898 acres;

10 (5) Fairbanks North Star Borough - 112,000 acres;

11 (6) Haines Borough - 2,800 acres;

12 (7) Kenai Peninsula Borough - 155,780 acres;

13 (8) Ketchikan Gateway Borough - 11,593 acres;

14 (9) Kodiak Island Borough - 56,500 acres;

15 (10) Lake and Peninsula Borough - 125,000 acres;

- 1 (11) Matanuska-Susitna Borough - 355,210 acres;
- 2 (12) North Slope Borough - 89,850 acres;
- 3 **(13) Denali Borough - 71,000 acres.**

4 * **Sec. 2.** AS 29.65.040(c) is amended to read:

5 (c) Land may be selected or nominated for selection by a municipality to
6 satisfy a general grant land entitlement under former AS 29.18.201 and 29.18.202 at
7 any time before October 1, 1980. Land may be selected or nominated for selection by
8 a municipality to satisfy a general grant land entitlement under AS 29.65.010(a)(1) -
9 (9), (11), or (12) at any time before October 1, 1990. Land may be selected or
10 nominated for selection by a municipality to satisfy a general grant land entitlement
11 under AS 29.65.010(a)(10) at any time before October 1, 1996. **Land may be**
12 **selected or nominated for selection by a municipality to satisfy a general grant**
13 **land entitlement under AS 29.65.010(a)(13) at any time before October 1, 1998.**

14 However, if a municipal selection or nomination or a part of a municipal selection or
15 nomination is rejected by the director, the municipality may, not later than 90 days
16 after receipt of the rejection or final decision on an appeal filed under
17 AS 29.65.050(d), select additional state land as necessary to satisfy its entitlement.
