**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

**1 "An Act relating to the management of anadromous fisheries."**

**2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

**3 \* Section 1.** AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to article 5 to read:

**4**           Sec. 16.05.735.   MANAGEMENT FOR TERMINAL ANADROMOUS  
**5**   FISHERIES. (a) Subject to provisions of applicable treaties, the Board of Fisheries  
**6**   and the department shall, consistent with their respective authority under this title and  
**7**   to the extent practicable, give priority to the harvest of anadromous fish by terminal  
**8**   fisheries over the harvest by nonterminal fisheries.

**9**           (b) In this section, "terminal fishery" means a fishery occurring in, or in salt  
**10**   water adjacent to, a river, a river system, or group of rivers in which fisheries are  
**11**   managed as a unit.
