FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to payment of costs and attorney fees in a class action filed**
2 **against the state; and providing for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 09.50.280 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if judgment is entered against
6 the state in a class action, the court may not require the state to pay costs or attorney
7 fees incurred in bringing the class action.

8 * **Sec. 2.** APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to a class action that accrues on or after the
9 effective date of this Act.

10 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect July 1, 1995.
