A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act providing for an advisory vote regarding regaining state management
2 of fish and game throughout this state; and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** The lieutenant governor shall place before the qualified voters of the state at
5 the November 1996 general election a question advisory to the legislature regarding whether
6 steps should be taken to regain state management of fish and game throughout this state. The
7 question shall appear on the ballot in the following form:

8 **QUESTION**

9 Should the people of Alaska be given an opportunity to vote on
10 an amendment to the Alaska Constitution that would allow the
11 State of Alaska to have a preference for subsistence use of fish
12 and wildlife by rural residents?
