**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to the sale of farmed salmon products."

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** AS 17.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Sec. 17.05.025. Sale of farmed salmon products.** (a) A person may not sell,  
5 trade, or barter a farmed salmon product in the state.

6 (b) In this section, "farmed salmon product" means a food product that  
7 contains salmon that is propagated, farmed, or cultivated in an aquatic farm; in this  
8 subsection,

9 (1) "aquatic farm" means a facility that grows, farms, or cultivates  
10 salmon in captivity or under positive control, but does not include a salmon hatchery  
11 that is owned by the state or that holds a salmon hatchery permit under AS 16.10.400;

12 (2) "positive control" has the meaning given in AS 16.40.199;

13 (3) "salmon" means a Pacific salmon, Atlantic salmon, or hybrid  
14 salmon.

15 \* **Sec. 2.** AS 17.20.040(12) and 17.20.370(7) are repealed.
