A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to notification of the public concerning sex offenders."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 *** Section 1.** AS 18.65.087(d) is amended to read:

4 (d) The Department of Public Safety

5 (1) shall adopt regulations to

6 (A) allow a sex offender to review sex offender registration
7 information that refers to that sex offender [,] and, if the sex offender believes
8 the information is inaccurate or incomplete, to request the department to correct
9 the information; if the department finds the information is inaccurate or
10 incomplete, the department shall correct or supplement the information;

11 (B) ensure the appropriate circulation to law enforcement
12 agencies of information contained in the central registry;

13 **(C) provide notice of the name and address of a sex offender**
14 **and the crime for which the sex offender was convicted to**

15 **(i) each residence and business within a one-mile**

1 **radius of the address where the sex offender resides in a rural area**
2 **and within a three square block area of the address where the sex**
3 **offender resides in an urban area;**

4 **(ii) the superintendent of the school district in which**
5 **the sex offender resides; and**

6 **(iii) other persons the department determines**
7 **appropriate to notify;**

8 (2) shall provide to municipal police departments the forms and
9 directions necessary to allow sex offenders to comply with AS 12.63.010;

10 (3) may adopt regulations to establish fees to be charged for registration
11 under AS 12.63.010 and for information requests; the fee for registration shall be based
12 upon the actual costs of performing the registration and maintaining the central registry
13 but may not be set at a level whereby registration is discouraged; the fee for an
14 information request may not be greater than \$10;

15 (4) shall remove from the central registry of sex offenders under **this**
16 **section** [AS 18.65.087] information about a sex offender required to register under
17 AS 12.63.020(a)(2) at the end of the sex offender's duty to register if the offender has
18 not been convicted of another sex offense; in this paragraph, "sex offense" has the
19 meaning given in AS 12.63.100.
