A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act requiring certain motor vehicles to yield to following traffic."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 28.35.140 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (b) A person operating a motor vehicle on a single lane roadway shall pull the
5 motor vehicle off the roadway at the first opportunity to safely pull over whenever
6 there is at least 100 feet of visible and unobstructed roadway in front of that motor
7 vehicle and there are five or more motor vehicles immediately following that motor
8 vehicle. A person who violates this subsection is guilty of an infraction as described
9 in AS 28.40.050(d) and may be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.
