**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to municipal fees for certain police and fire protection services."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** SHORT TITLE. Section 3 of this Act may be cited as the Crack House  
4 Abatement Act.

5 \* **Sec. 2.** AS 29.10.200 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

6 (54) AS 29.35.125 (fees for police and fire protection services).

7 \* **Sec. 3.** AS 29.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

8 **Sec. 29.35.125. Fees for police and fire protection services.** (a) A  
9 municipality may by ordinance impose a fee on the owner of residential real property  
10 if a member of the municipal police or fire department goes to the property an  
11 excessive number of times during a calendar year in response to a call for assistance,  
12 a complaint, an emergency, or a potential emergency. The number of responses  
13 considered to be excessive and the amount of the fee shall be set out in the ordinance  
14 that establishes the fee.

15 (b) This section applies to home rule and general law municipalities.
