A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to private maintenance of state highways."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 19.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 Sec. 19.10.095. Private maintenance of state highways. A person who
5 undertakes to maintain a state highway that the department normally maintains but has
6 determined not to maintain during the winter shall, to the extent feasible, provide for
7 multiple type vehicle access to allow public access to public lands adjacent to the state
8 highway. A person who undertakes to maintain a state highway that is not maintained
9 by the department may not recover compensation from the state or the public for the
10 costs that the person incurs in maintaining a state highway. A person may not recover
11 civil damages from the state for personal injury, death, or property damage resulting
12 from the private maintenance of a state highway that the department has determined
13 not to maintain during the winter and has posted that persons travel at their own risk.
