**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to the right to refuse to sell, give, or serve an alcoholic  
2 beverage."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 \* **Section 1.** AS 04.21.055 is amended to read:

5 **Sec. 04.21.055. Refusal of service.** A licensee, an agent, or an employee may  
6 refuse to sell, give, or serve alcoholic beverages to a person if the licensee, agent, or  
7 employee reasonably believes that the consumption of alcohol by that person may  
8 result in serious harm to that person or to others, **including the unborn child of that**  
9 **person.**
