A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to civil liability for activities of volunteer school crossing guards;**
2 **and providing for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 09.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 09.65.094. Civil liability for activities of volunteer crossing guard.** A
6 person who provides volunteer crossing guard services to assist students to reach or
7 depart from a public school and the school district in which the school is located may
8 not be held civilly liable for damages resulting from an act or omission in performing
9 the crossing guard services, unless the act or omission constitutes gross negligence,
10 recklessness, or intentional misconduct. In this section, "volunteer" means a person
11 who does not receive monetary compensation for performing services.

12 *** Sec. 2.** This Act applies to a claim for relief that accrues on or after the effective date
13 of this Act.

14 *** Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect July 1, 1998.
