A RESOLUTION

1 Suspending Uniform Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e) of the Alaska State
2 Legislature concerning Senate Bill No. 274, relating to probation and parole fees;
3 relating to eligibility for a permanent fund dividend for persons convicted of
4 certain offenses; and to notice requirements relating to appropriations from the
5 permanent fund dividend fund to the office of victims' rights.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 That under Rule 54 of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the
8 provisions of Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e) of the Uniform Rules, regarding changes to the
9 title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of Senate Bill No. 274, relating to probation and
10 parole fees; relating to eligibility for a permanent fund dividend for persons convicted of
11 certain offenses; and to notice requirements relating to appropriations from the permanent fund
12 dividend fund to the office of victims' rights.
