A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act establishing a division of consumer protection in the Department of Law;
2 and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 44.23 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 44.23.022. Division of consumer protection.** (a) There is created in the
6 Department of Law the division of consumer protection. The director of consumer
7 protection is appointed by the attorney general and serves at the pleasure of the
8 attorney general.

9 (b) The division of consumer protection shall

10 (1) carry out the duties of the attorney general under AS 45 and other
11 laws relating to consumer affairs and consumer protection; and

12 (2) annually make recommendations to the governor and the legislature
13 for statutory changes that are needed to ensure adequate protection of consumers in
14 this state.

1 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect July 1, 1997.
