FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to prohibiting recovery of damages and prohibiting a remedy
2 to a person in a civil action."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 09.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 09.65.215. Prohibiting damages or remedy when a person is at fault.**

6 A person may not recover civil damages or request a civil remedy if the damages or
7 remedy results in the person achieving a benefit from the person's own wrongdoing.
