A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to a volunteer fire fighter license plate."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 28.10.181 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (t) Special request volunteer fire fighter plates. Upon application by the owner
5 of a passenger vehicle, noncommercial van or pick-up truck, or motor home, the
6 department may design and issue registration plates that identify the vehicle as
7 registered to a member of a volunteer fire department. The department may
8 disapprove the issuance of registration plates under this subsection when the requested
9 plates are a duplication of an existing registration.

10 * **Sec. 2.** AS 28.10.421(d) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

11 (14) special request volunteer fire fighter plates \$50
12 plus the fee required for that vehicle under (b)(1) or (2) of this section; the fee
13 required by this paragraph shall be collected only on the first issuance and on the
14 replacement of special request plates; the commissioner of administration shall
15 separately account for the fees received under this paragraph that the department

1 deposits in the general fund; notwithstanding (g) of this section, the annual estimated
2 balance in the account that is in excess of the cost of issuing special request plates
3 may be appropriated by the legislature to the Department of Public Safety for the
4 support of programs benefiting fire fighter training.
