**A RESOLUTION**

**1 Suspending Uniform Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e) of the Alaska State  
2 Legislature concerning House Bill No. 2, relating to the permanent fund dividend  
3 program.**

**4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

**5 That under Rule 54 of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the  
6 provisions of Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e) of the Uniform Rules, regarding changes to the  
7 title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of House Bill No. 2, so that the title is "An Act  
8 requiring, for purposes of permanent fund dividend eligibility, an individual to have been  
9 physically present in the state for at least 72 consecutive hours during the prior two years before  
10 the current dividend year; relating, for purposes of permanent fund dividend eligibility, to  
11 allowable absences for secondary and postsecondary education on a full-time basis, vocational,  
12 professional, or other education on a full-time basis when a comparable program is not  
13 reasonably available in the state, serving on active duty as a member of the armed forces of the  
14 United States, receiving continuous medical treatment or convalescing if the treatment or  
15 convalescence is not based on a need for climatic change, providing care for certain relatives  
16 with critical life-threatening illnesses, providing care for certain terminally ill relatives, settling**

1 the estates of certain relatives, serving as a member of the United States Congress, serving on  
2 the staff of a member from this state of the United States Congress, serving as an employee of  
3 the state, participating in a teacher exchange program sponsored by the state, participating on  
4 a United States national athletic team as an eligible athlete, serving in the Peace Corps or as a  
5 volunteer in the Federal Emergency Management Agency, serving in the Foreign Service of the  
6 United States, accompanying certain ill minors, accompanying another eligible resident who is  
7 absent for an allowable reason as the spouse, minor dependent, or disabled dependent of the  
8 eligible resident, or for any reason consistent with an individual's intent to remain a state  
9 resident; prohibiting, for purposes of permanent fund dividend eligibility, an individual from  
10 claiming an allowable absence unless the individual was a resident for at least six consecutive  
11 months immediately before leaving the state; making ineligible, for purposes of permanent fund  
12 dividend eligibility, certain individuals who are absent for more than 180 days during each of  
13 10 qualifying years; relating to the definition of state 'resident' for purposes of permanent fund  
14 dividend eligibility and requiring a state resident to have the intent to remain indefinitely;  
15 relating to the qualifying year and defining that term for purposes of the permanent fund  
16 dividend program; relating to the eligibility for 1998 permanent fund dividends of certain  
17 spouses and dependents of eligible individuals; and providing for an effective date."
