A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to
2 participation in an abortion.

3 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** Article I, sec. 22, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended to read:

5 **Section 22. Right of privacy.** The right of the people to privacy is recognized
6 and shall not be infringed. Nothing in this constitution requires a hospital or
7 person to participate in an abortion. The legislature shall implement this section.

8 * **Sec. 2.** The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters
9 of the state at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution
10 of the State of Alaska, and the election laws of the state.
