A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the crime of failure to stop at the direction of a peace
2 officer; and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 28.35.182(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) A person commits the offense of failure to stop at the direction of a peace
6 officer in the first degree if the person violates (b) of this section, and, during the
7 commission of that offense, the person

8 (1) violates a traffic law or commits another crime; **and**

9 (2) exposes a peace officer or another person to a risk of serious
10 physical injury [. IN THIS SUBSECTION,

11 (1) "CRIME" HAS THE MEANING GIVEN IN AS 11.81.900;

12 (2) "TRAFFIC LAW" HAS THE MEANING GIVEN IN
13 AS 28.15.261].

14 * **Sec. 2.** AS 28.35.182(d) is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

- 1 (3) "crime" has the meaning given in AS 11.81.900;
- 2 (4) "serious physical injury" has the meaning given in AS 11.81.900;
- 3 (5) "traffic law" has the meaning given in AS 28.15.261.
- 4 * **Sec. 3.** Sections 1 and 2 of this Act are retroactive to September 23, 1998.
- 5 * **Sec. 4.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
