**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

**1 "An Act relating to reciting the pledge of allegiance by public school students."**

**2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

**3 \* Section 1.** AS 14.03.130 is amended to read:

**4           Sec. 14.03.130. Display of flags and pledge of allegiance [FLAG].** United  
**5 States and Alaska flags shall be displayed upon or near each principal school building**  
**6 during school hours and at other times the governing body considers proper. The**  
**7 governing body shall require that the pledge of allegiance be recited daily, as**  
**8 determined by the governing body. A person may recite the following salute to**  
**9 the flag of the United States or maintain a respectful silence: "I pledge allegiance**  
**10 to the flag of the United States of America and to the republic for which it stands,**  
**11 one nation under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all."**
