A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to legislative powers and responsibility with respect to collective
2 bargaining agreements between the state and a labor or employee organization
3 representing state employees; and providing for an effective date."

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

5 * Section 1. AS 23.40.215(a) is amended to read:

6 (a) The monetary terms of any agreement entered into under AS 23.40.070 -
7 23.40.260 are subject to funding through legislative appropriation. If the legislature
8 does not fund the monetary terms of an agreement, none of the provisions of the
9 agreement take effect. For a multiyear agreement, if the legislature funds the
10 monetary terms for a year, the nonmonetary terms take effect for that year and
11 remain in effect for the duration of the agreement.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 23.40.215(b) is amended to read:

13 (b) The Department of Administration shall submit the monetary terms of an
14 agreement to the legislature within 10 legislative days after the agreement of the

1 parties, if the legislature is in session, or within 10 legislative days after the convening
2 of the next regular session. **Unless otherwise authorized by the legislature, the final**
3 **agreement shall be submitted to the legislature no later than the 45th day of the**
4 **legislative session to receive legislative consideration during that calendar year**
5 [THE LEGISLATURE SHALL ADVISE THE PARTIES BY CONCURRENT
6 RESOLUTION IF IT APPROVES OR DISAPPROVES OF THE MONETARY
7 TERMS WITHIN 60 LEGISLATIVE DAYS AFTER THE AGREEMENT IS
8 SUBMITTED TO THE LEGISLATURE. THE APPROVAL OF THE MONETARY
9 TERMS OF AN AGREEMENT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS A NONBINDING,
10 ADVISORY EXPRESSION OF LEGISLATIVE INTENT. IF WITHIN 60
11 LEGISLATIVE DAYS AFTER THE AGREEMENT IS SUBMITTED THE
12 LEGISLATURE ADVISES THE PARTIES BY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
13 THAT IT DISAPPROVES THE MONETARY TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT, THE
14 PARTIES MAY RESUME NEGOTIATIONS].

15 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
