SCS CSHB 151 (FIN) makes several changes to the statutes relating to revocation of driver's licenses for minors possessing and/or consuming alcohol. The length of time an administrative revocation lasts is decreased, and more time is granted to request an administrative review of the revocation. Administrative driver's license revocations under AS 28.15.183, the "Use it, lose it" law, would be applied concurrently, rather than consecutively. And the bill would allow license reinstatement under certain circumstances.

This bill will have no fiscal impact on the Department of Law.
