* Regulations that are not required by statute will rarely meet the standard of being "clearly necessary", added by the CS. The probable result will be fewer new regulations but more litigation to resolve issues usually addressed in regulations concerning the application of statutes. The new time limits on administrative adjudication in the CS will shift resolution of more of these policy issues from administrative appeals to the courts, which will increase the time and expense involved. Although it is reasonable to assume substantial cost increases associated with litigation, it is not possible to make an accurate estimate of fiscal impact at this time
