ANALYSIS: *(Attach a separate page if necessary)*

SB 91 sets up a direct conflict with federal law by making it illegal for federal employees to enforce federal statutes and regulations that are inconsistent with the Alaska Constitution. The United States will likely challenge this provision in Federal Court to protect its employees from the threat of prosecution by the State of Alaska. Defending the law in the resulting lawsuit will have an indeterminate, but significant, workload and financial impact on the department. In addition, there will be costs involved in prosecuting federal employees who violate the law.

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
