ANALYSIS: *(Attach a separate page if necessary)*

This bill adds ketamine hydrochloride to Schedule IVA as a controlled substance. If enacted, the manufacture, delivery, or possession, under certain circumstances, of this substance would be a class C felony.

Ketamine hydrochloride is a synthetic drug developed as an anesthetic, commonly used by veterinarians. The side effects of its use by humans can include hallucinations, agitation, and delirium. The drug is currently being abused because of these side effects.

The drug is not yet common in Alaska, and while evidence indicates abuse may increase, the Department of Law does not anticipate at this time a fiscal impact from passage of this bill.
